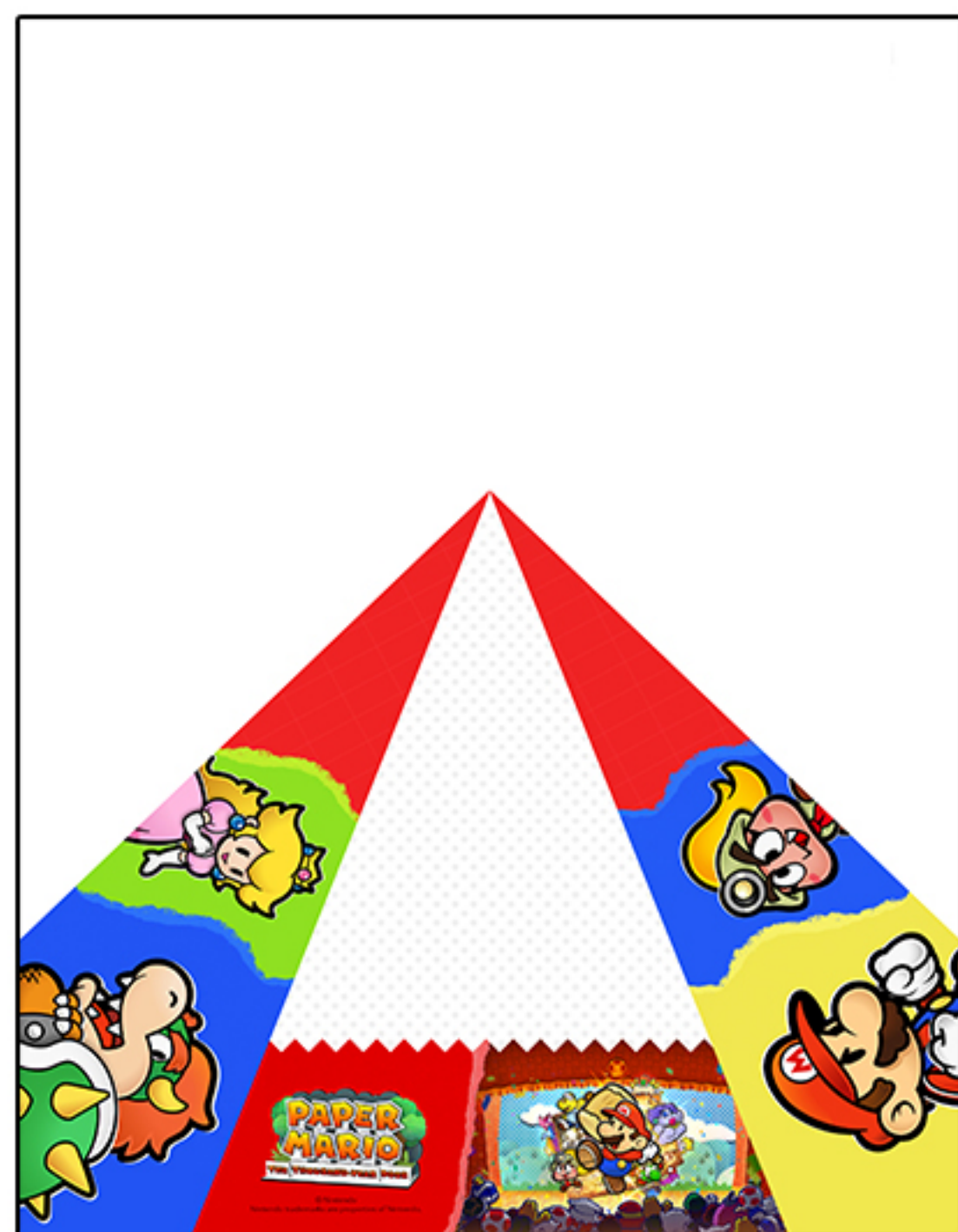
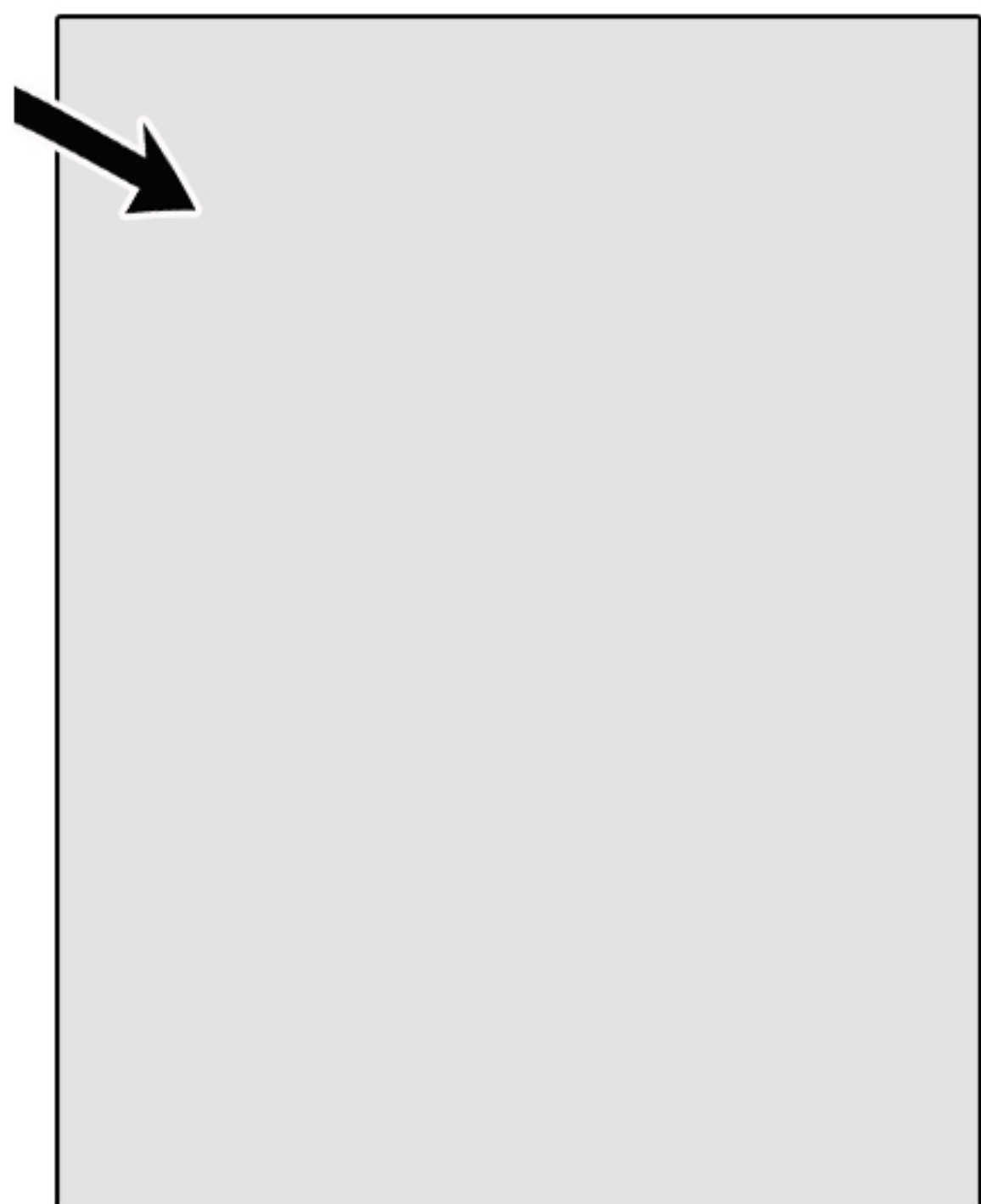


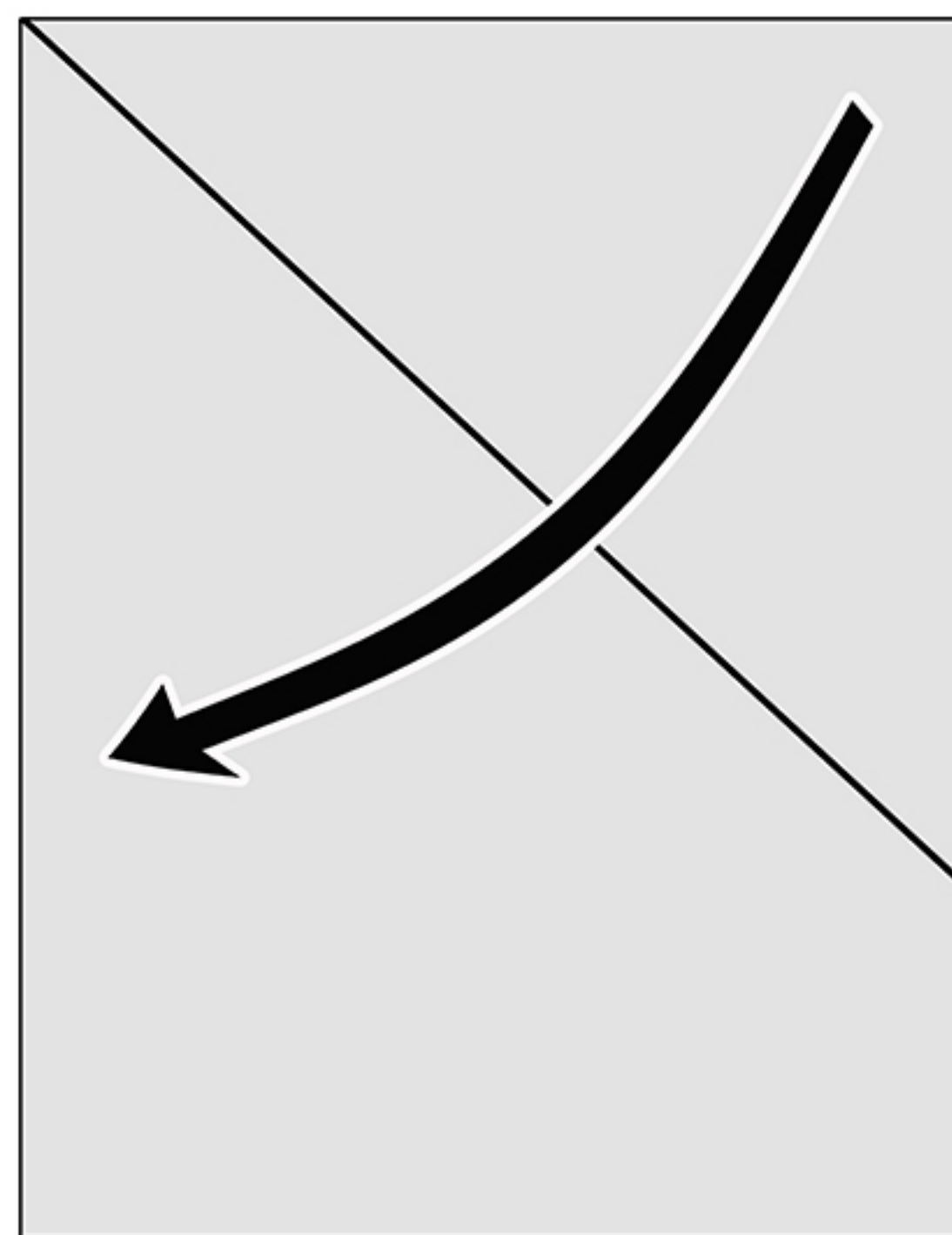
## PAPER AIRPLANE INSTRUCTIONS



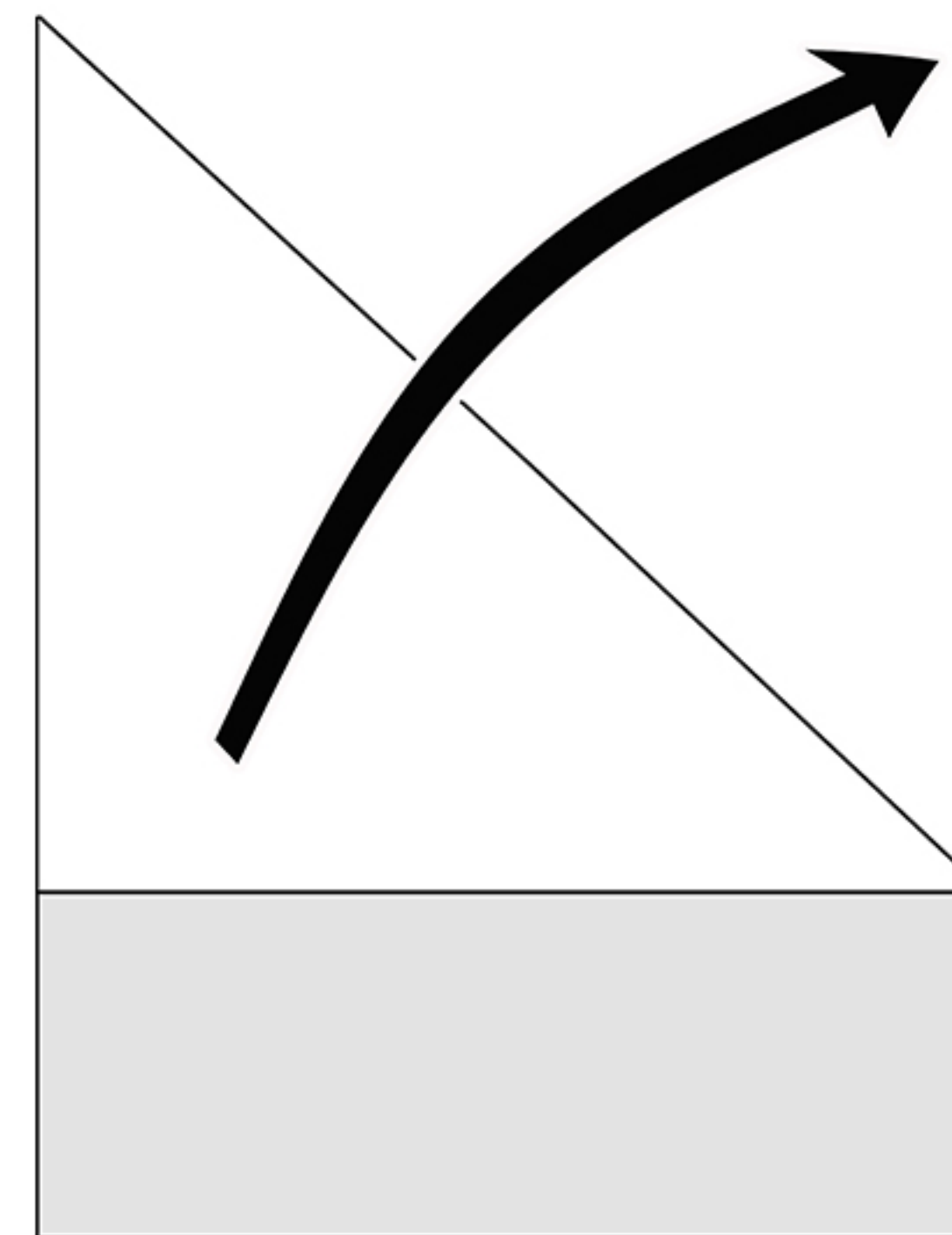
1. Print out template.



2. Flip the printed side over and start on the blank side. The images will align at the end.



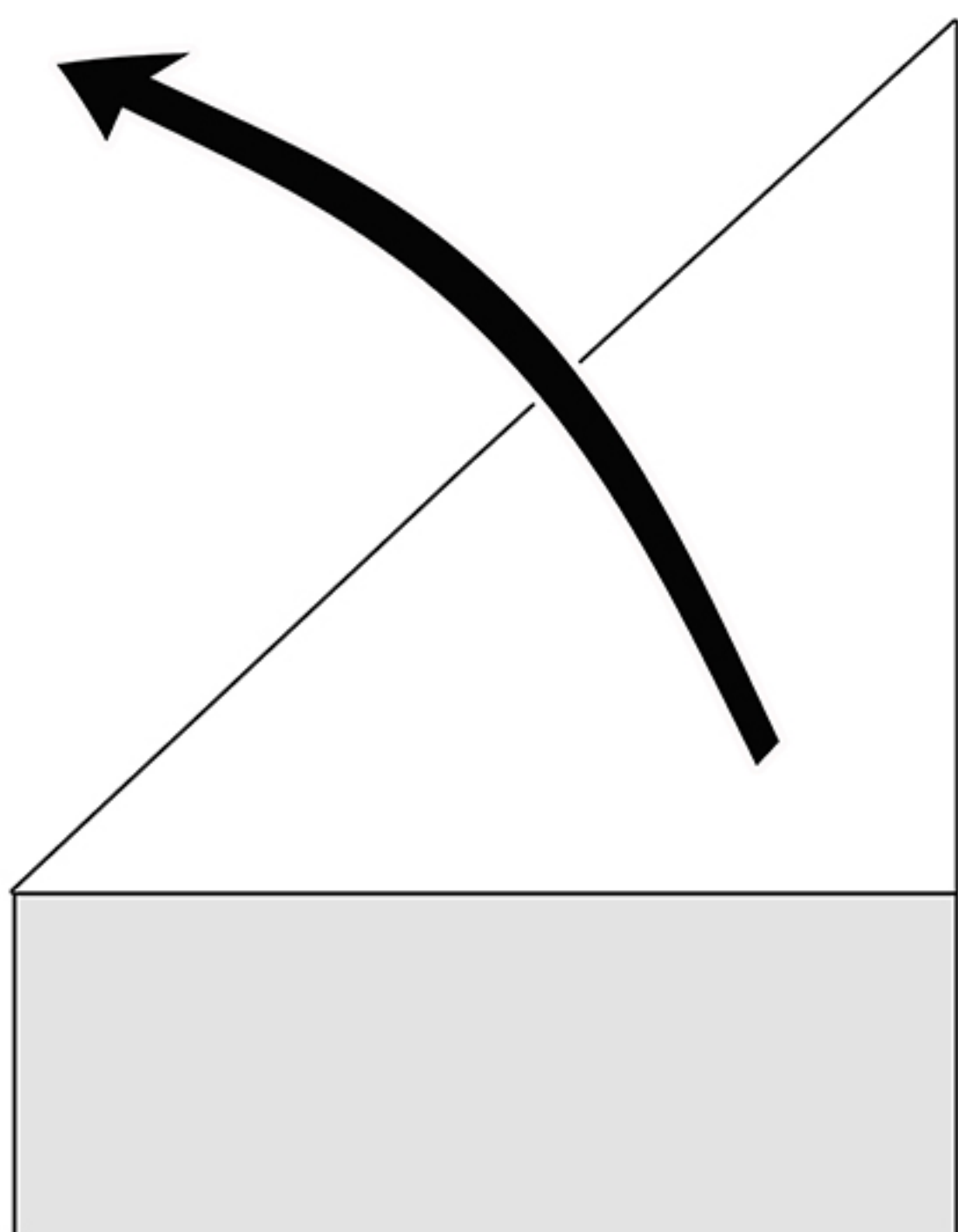
3. Diagonal fold right side.



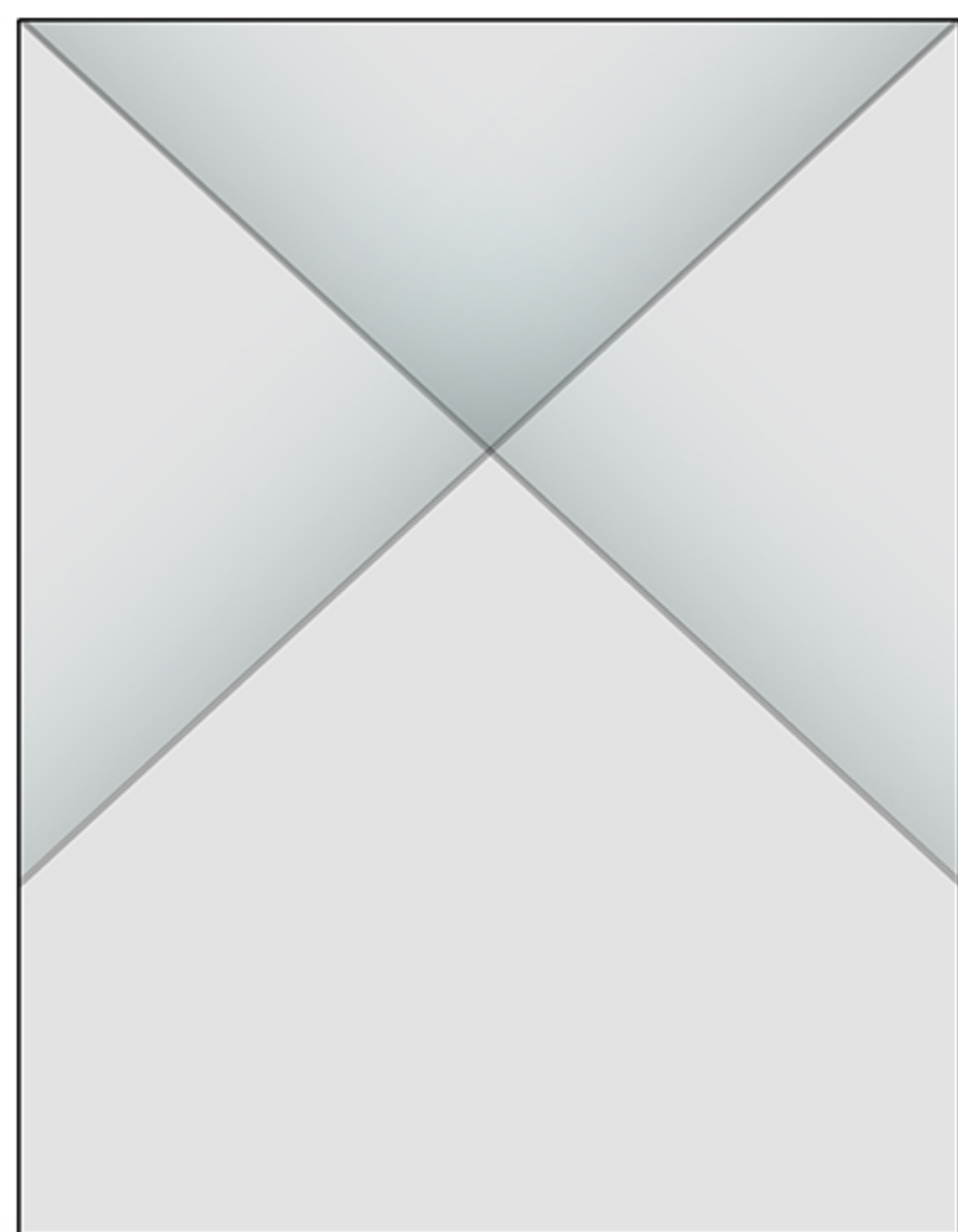
4. Open up again to see your crease.



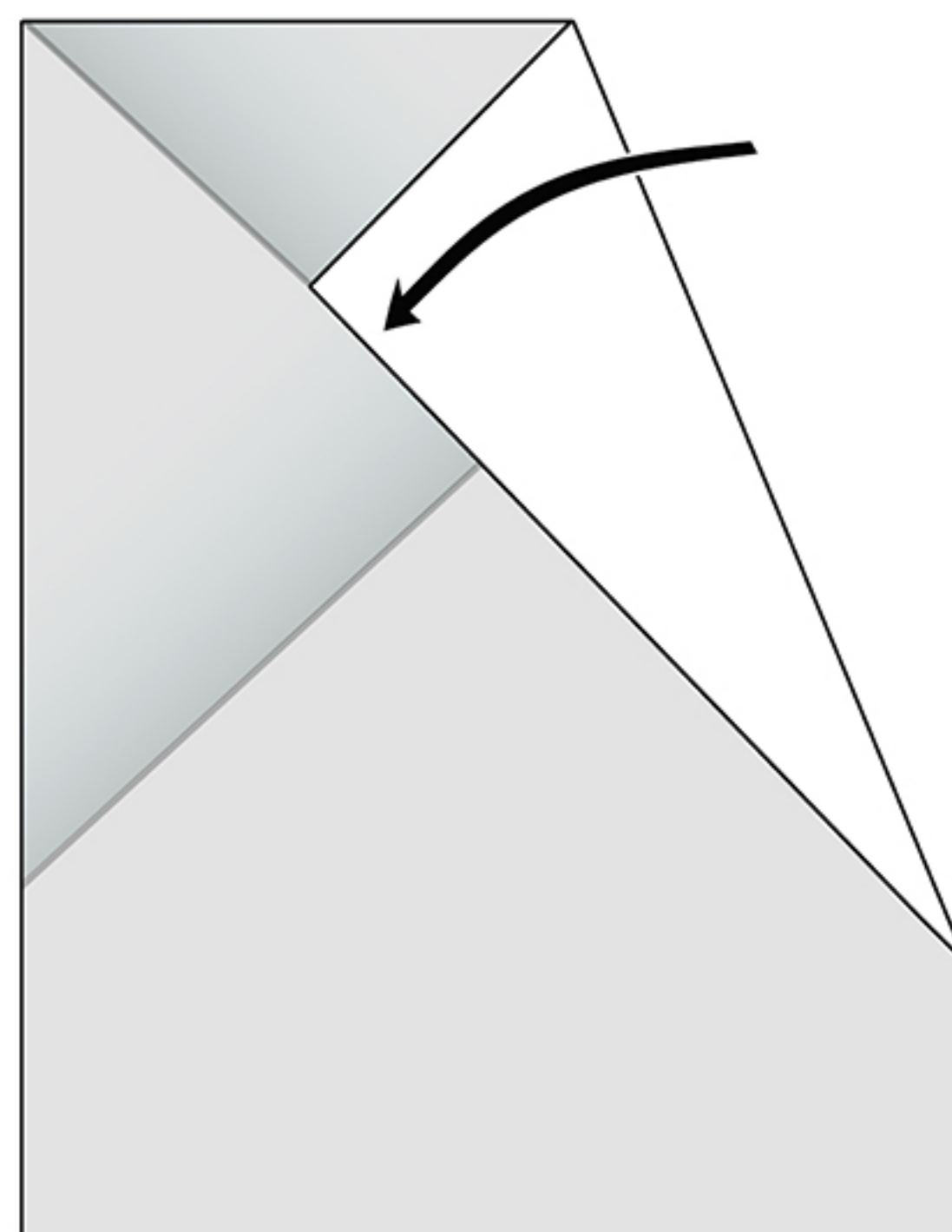
5. Diagonal fold left side.



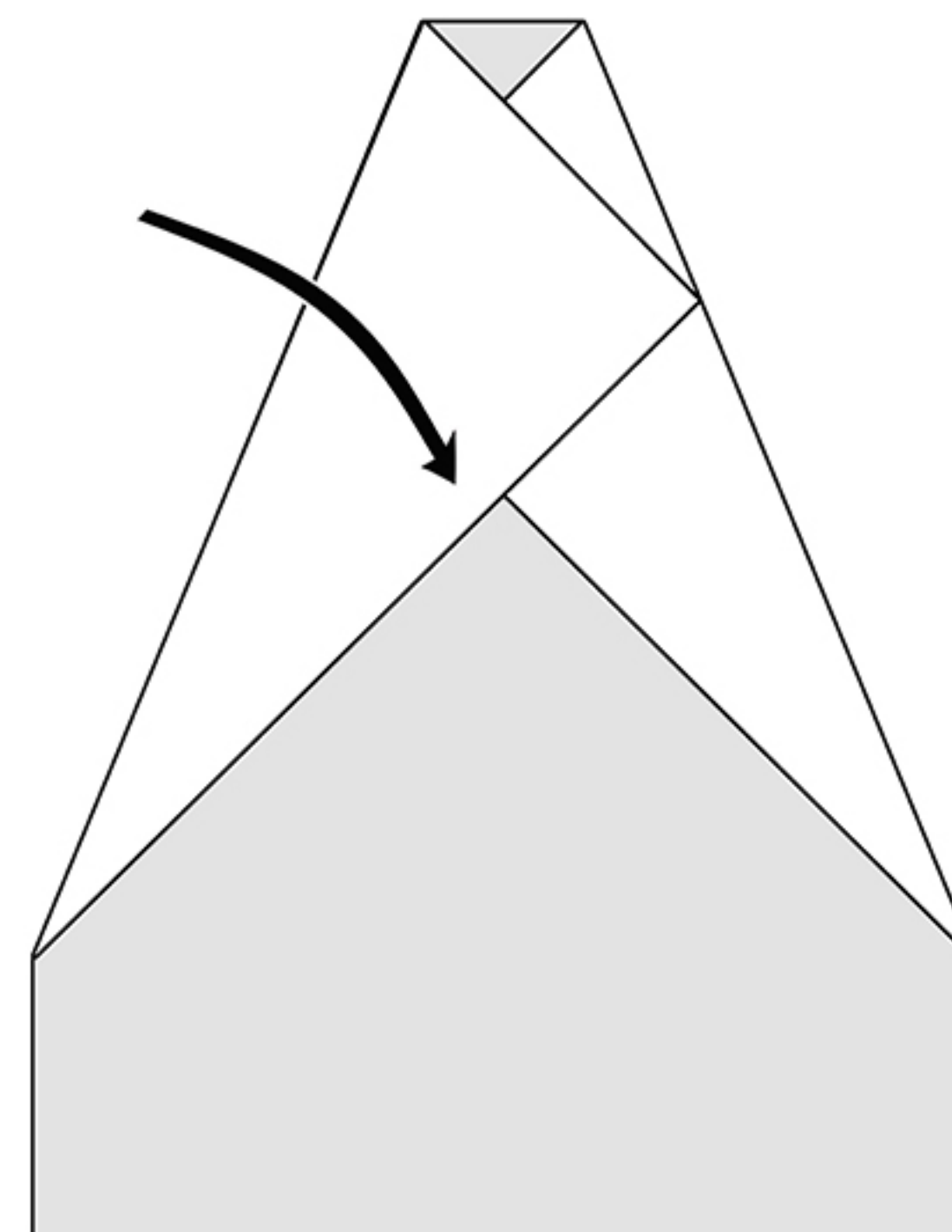
6. Open up again to see your creases.



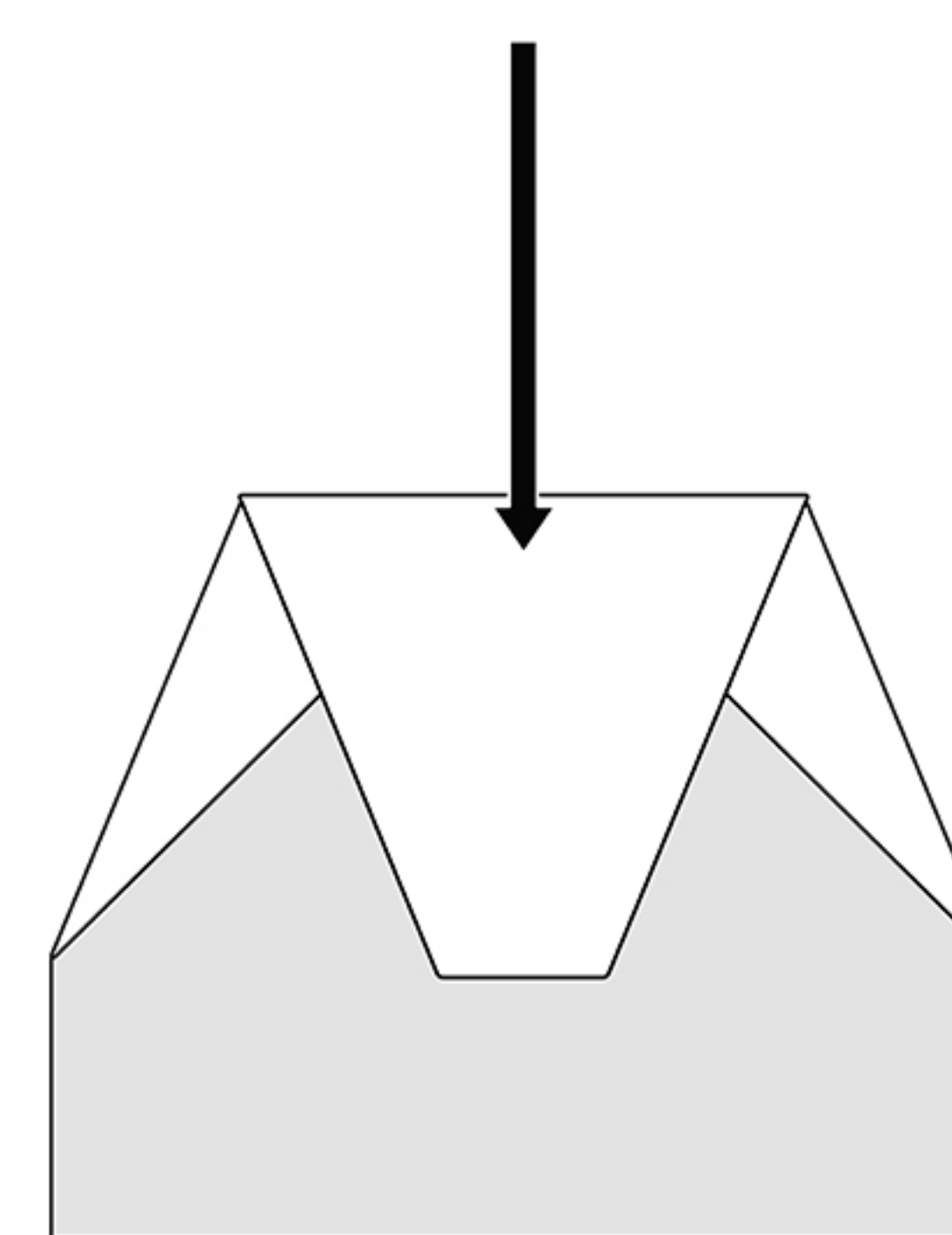
7. Use this X fold to guide yourself through the next steps.



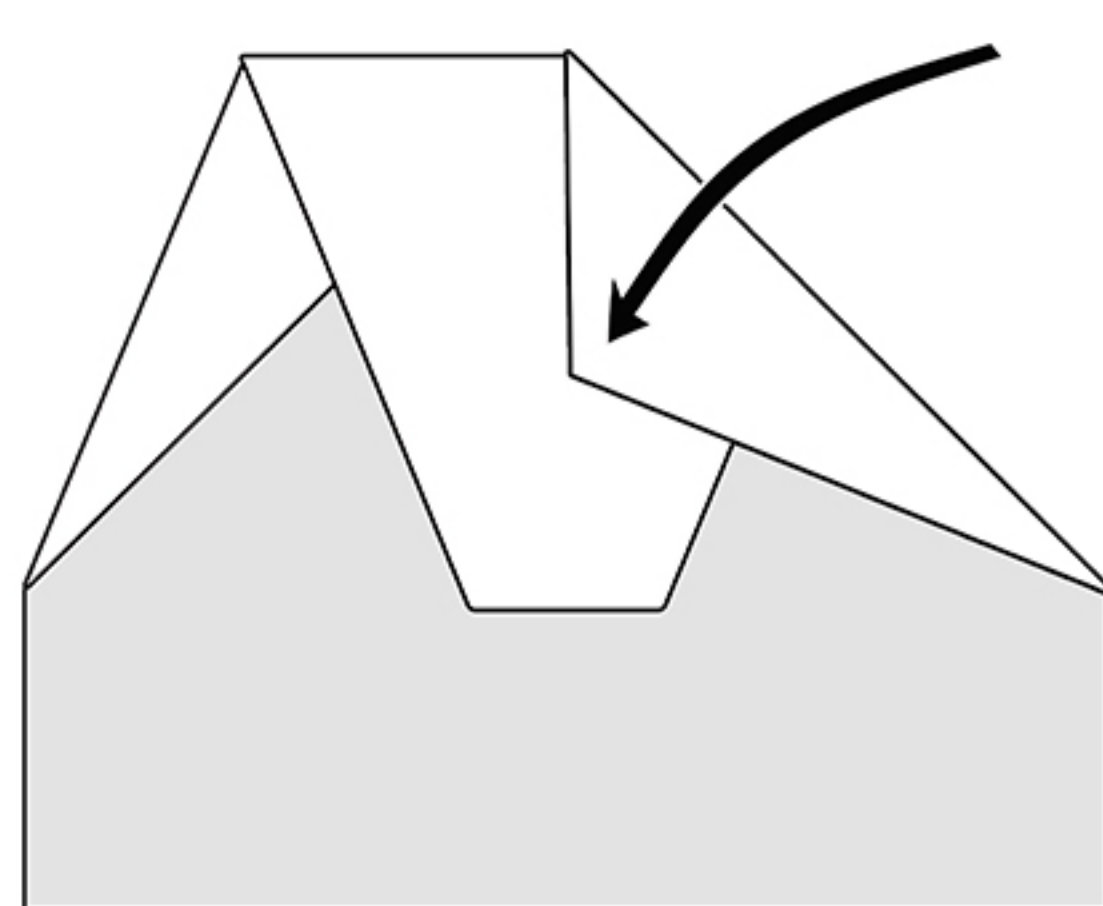
8. Fold the righthand edge so it lines up with the diagonal fold crease.



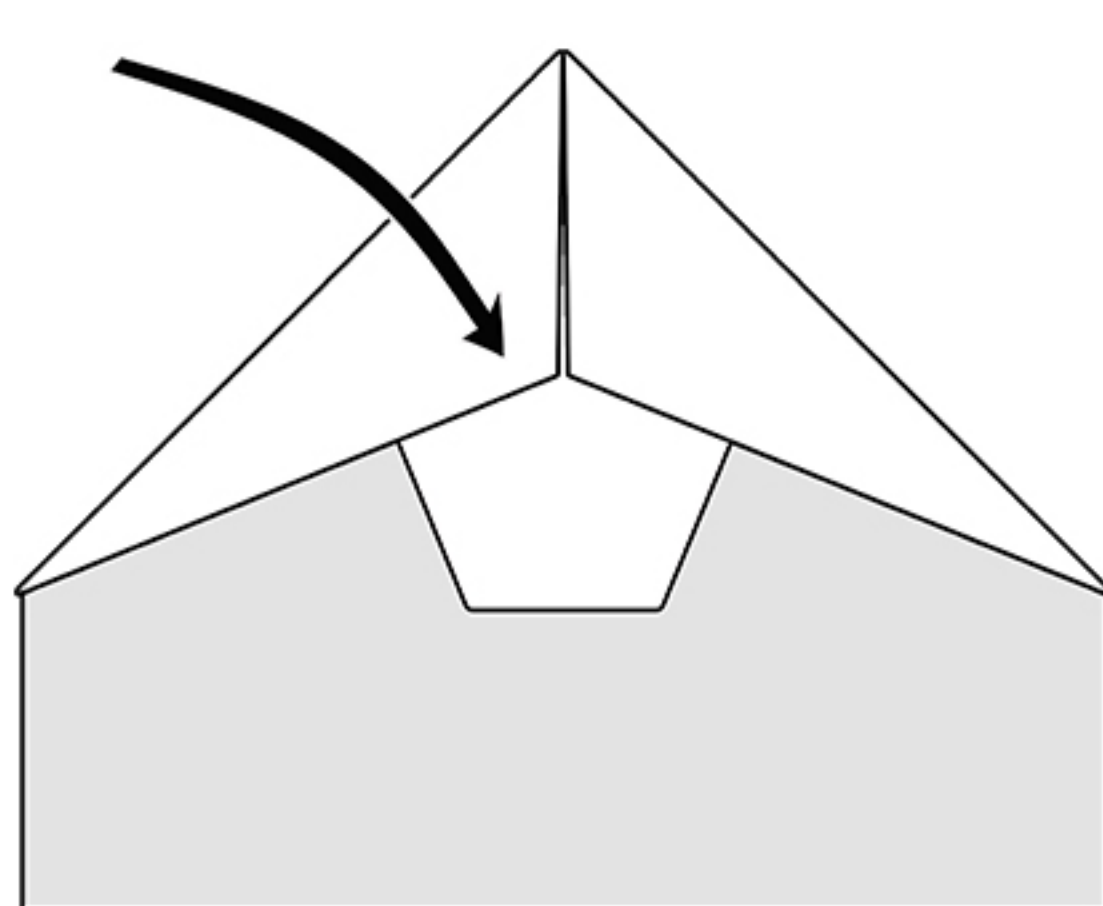
9. Fold the lefthand edge so it lines up with the other diagonal fold crease.



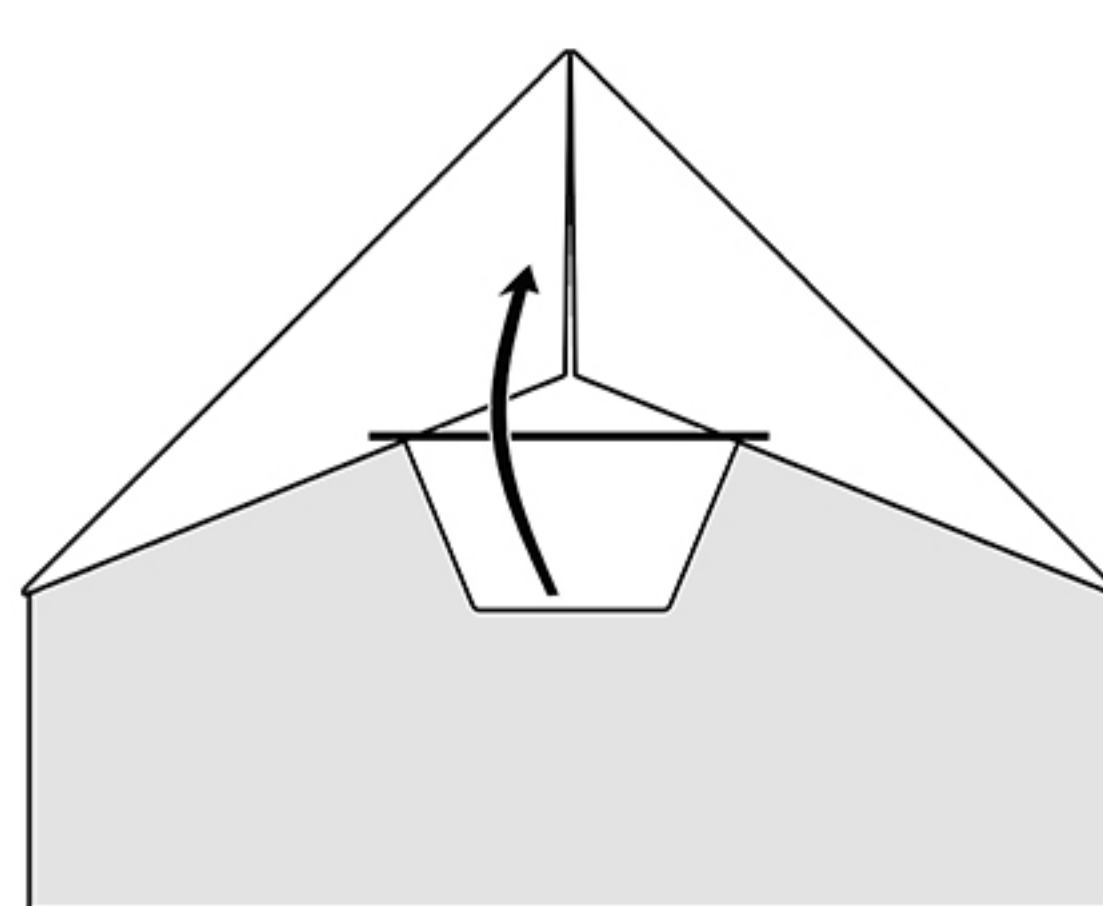
10. Fold down from the top to where the diagonal lines meet at the center of the X.



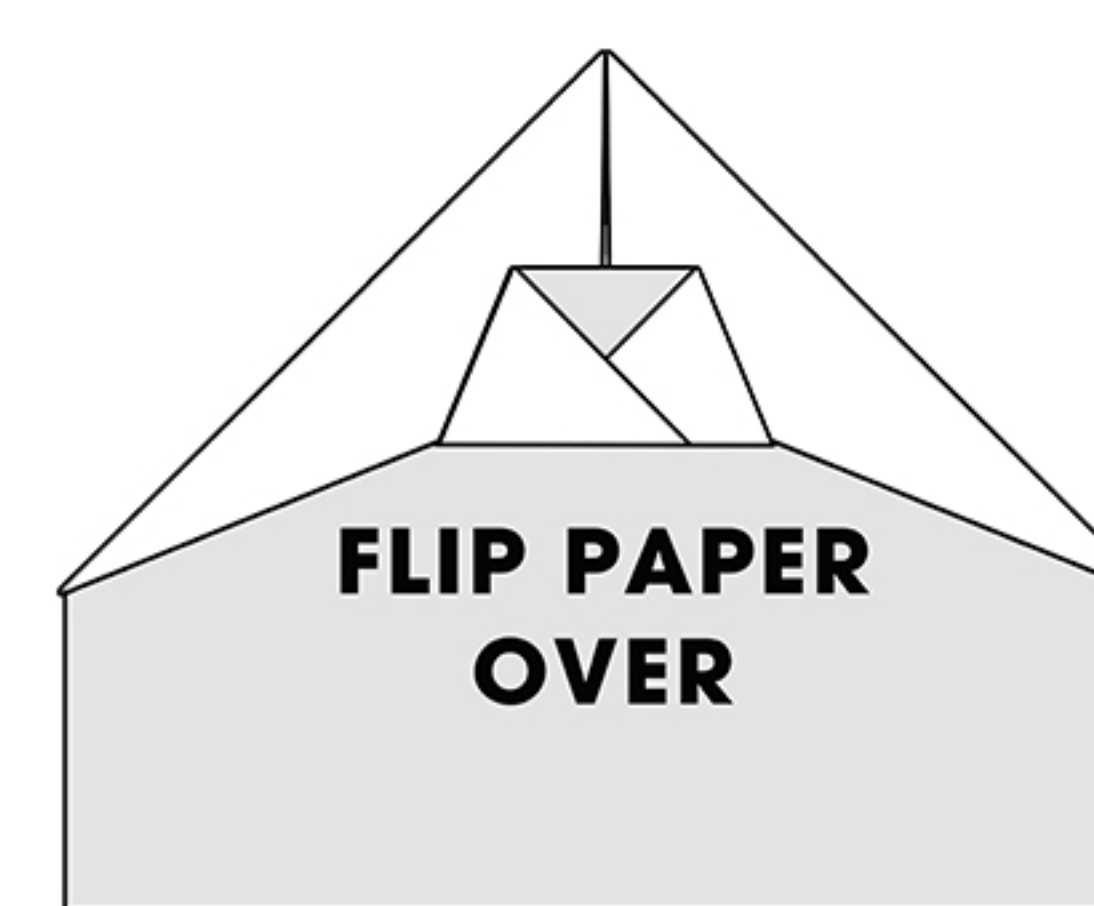
11. Fold the right corner down again towards the center.



12. Now fold the left side to create a point at the top.



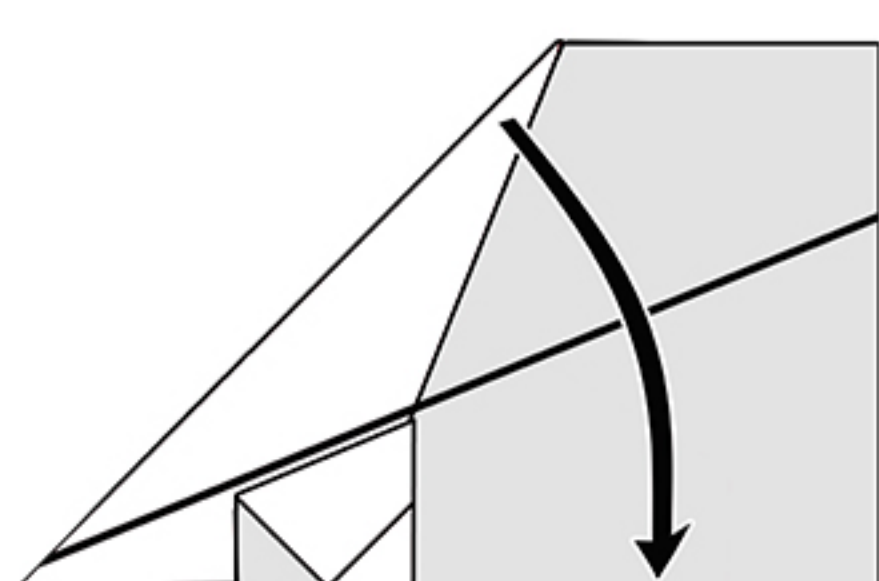
13. Fold middle flap up over the two corners to hold wings in place.



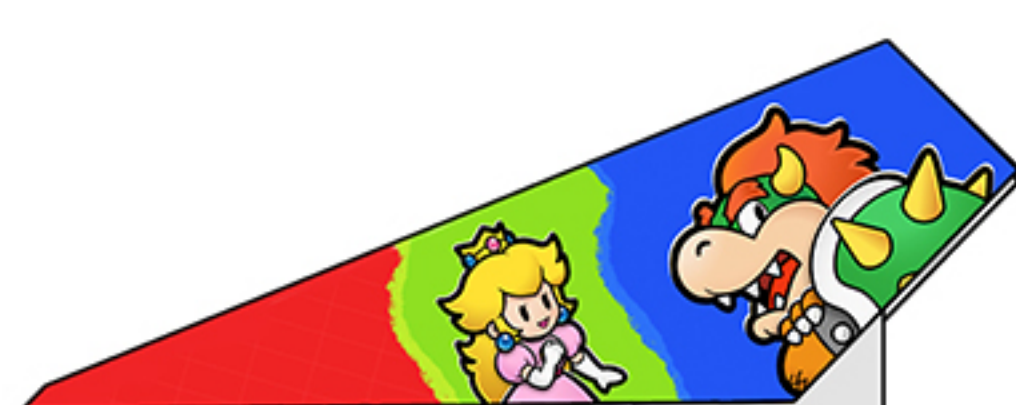
14. With the middle flap folded to hold the wings in place, carefully flip the paper over.



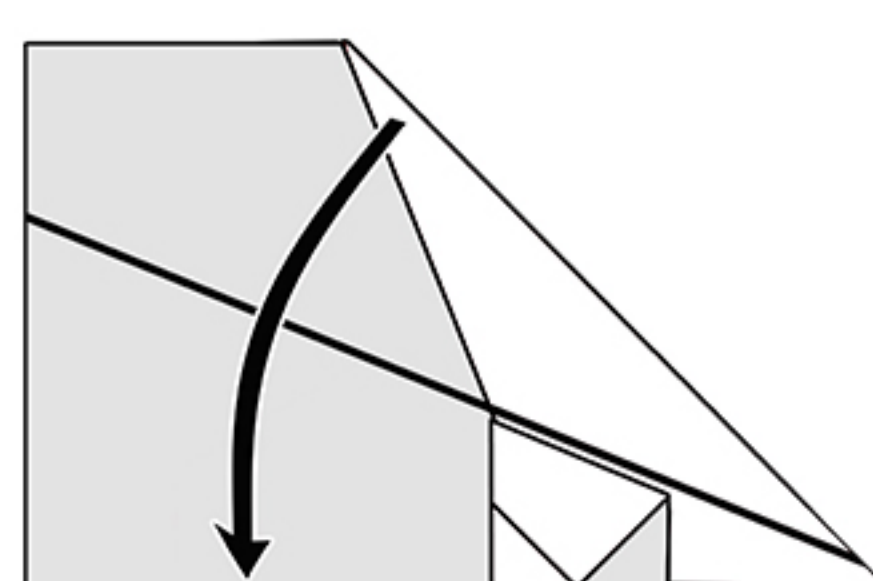
15. On the printed side, fold the plane in half.



16. Rotate paper to the left side then make a wing fold.



17. First wing done, flip to the other side.



18. Make the other wing fold.

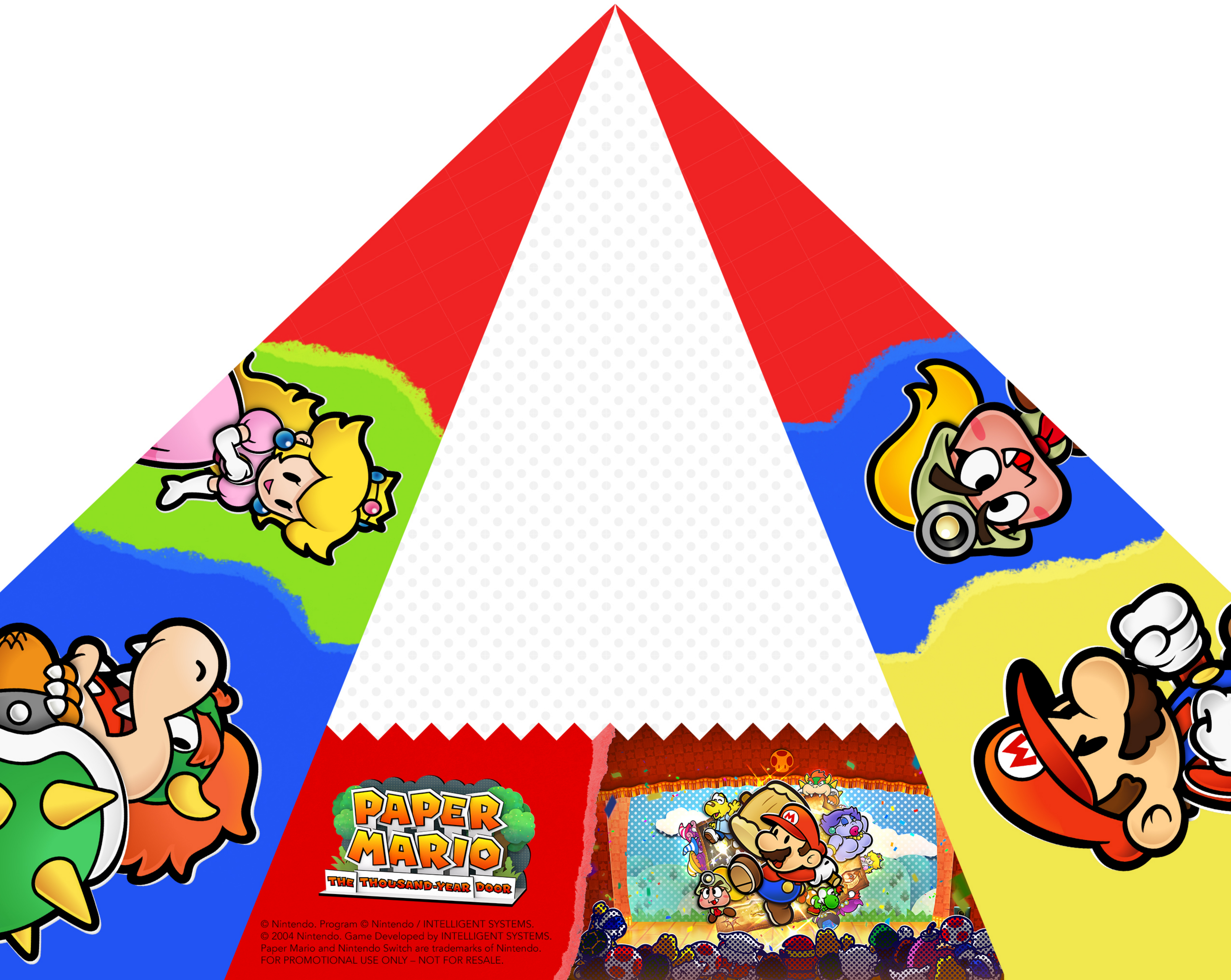


19. Your plane is complete!
