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## 2022-2023 Consortium Agreement Terms

The purpose of this agreement is to allow Irvine Valley College students to enroll in transferable course work at another college and receive financial aid for those units from IVC. For the purpose of this agreement, IVC will be considered the **home** campus and the other school will be the **host** campus. Students who benefit from this agreement will be eligible for financial aid only at the **home** campus (IVC). In addition, the following terms apply:

- All courses taken must be applicable to the program of study at IVC and the must have a current MAP on file with IVC. Counseling may be contacted to confirm course applicability.
- An unofficial transcript or enrollment verification is needed from the host college prior to any disbursements being made. *Please note the schedule on the Consortium Agreements page on the Financial Aid Office website.*
- The student may **not** be receiving federal aid from the host campus or any other school for the term involved in the agreement.
- The student must be enrolled in **6 - 11.5 units at Irvine Valley College**. If you are enrolled in 12 or more units at Irvine Valley College, you are already receiving your full award and do not need to submit this form for Pell Grant and Cal Grant only.
- The majority of units for the term being considered must be at IVC.
- The student must have a complete financial aid file at IVC.
- Both IVC and the host campus must be eligible for Title IV funding under the Higher Education Act of 1965.
- Students must provide an unofficial transcript of their enrollment prior to the second half of their Pell Grant being disbursed for the term. Please see the Consortium Agreements page on the Financial Aid Office website.
- A final official transcript must be submitted once the course(s) has been completed before any disbursements for a subsequent term are made. The student will need to setup an appointment with Counseling to update their MAP to determine remaining courses needed.
- Courses taken at the host campus will be considered in the student's overall satisfactory academic progress status.
- Funds for a subsequent term will not be released until the final official transcript is submitted to IVC for class(es) taken as part of the consortium agreement.
